

2022 ICE SHOW PROTOCOLS AND REMINDERS

Thursday, March 9th – Because this is a sanctioned event, all skaters are required to be masked while in the locker rooms and behind the back drop. *Skaters will not be required to wear them while performing.* Rehearsal starts at 5:00 P.M. in the Event rink. Skaters that are in the first half should be ready to go promptly at 5:00 PM. Any skaters who are in the second half can arrive at 5:30 PM and be ready to go. Once a skater has skated in their group(s), they are free to go home.

Friday, March 10th –

Picture Retakes- 4:30 PM in the Event Rink. Dress rehearsal starts at 5:00 P.M. in the Event rink. Be sure you have your tights, costumes, masks and skates on. Skaters should be dropped off at the skater entrance with their skates and masks on. Upon entering the arena, skaters will head to their assigned locker room. We will practice walking to the locker rooms and what will take place for the ice show. When a skater is finished skating, they are allowed to leave.

For the Dreams on Ice Shows- SATURDAY 6 P.M. AND SUNDAY 2 P.M.-

Skaters should be dropped off at the skater entrance with their costumes, tights, skates and masks on no earlier than an hour prior to the shows. Upon entering the arena, skaters will head to their assigned locker room. We will practice walking to the locker rooms and what will take place for the ice show. **DOORS FOR SKATING FAMILIES AND THE PUBLIC WILL OPEN 1 HOUR, PRIOR TO SHOW START TIME.**

REMINDERS:

- BE SURE ALL SKATERS GO TO THE RESTROOM BEFORE BRINGING THEM TO THE ARENA.
- FOR SKATERS IN THE FIRST HALF, THEY WILL HEAD DIRECTLY TO THEIR ASSIGNED LOCKER ROOM. THEY WILL THEN STAY THERE UNTIL THEY HAVE FINISHED SKATING THEIR ROUTINES. ONCE A SKATER HAS FINISHED ALL OF THEIR ROUTINES, THEY MAY JOIN THEIR FAMILY IN THE CROWD TO ENJOY THE REMAINDER OF THE SHOW. SKATERS IN THE SECOND HALF OF THE SHOW, MAY SIT WITH THEIR FAMILIES UNTIL INTERMISSION. DURING INTERMISSION, PLEASE BE SURE YOUR SKATER HAS USED THE RESTROOM AND AT THAT TIME HEAD TO THE ASSIGNED LOCKER ROOMS. ONCE THEY HAVE FINISHED SKATING, THEY MAY JOIN THEIR FAMILIES ONCE AGAIN.
- FOR EACH SHOW, PLEASE BE SURE SKATERS ARE WEARING SOME MAKE-UP – BLUSH, EYEMAKEUP AND LIPSTICK – THIS WILL BRIGHTEN UP THEIR FACE WHEN THEY ARE ON THE ICE.
- PLEASE MAKE SURE SKATES ARE TIED TIGHT AND LACES ARE TUCKED IN. IF A SKATER IS ONLY IN THE SECOND HALF, THEY CAN COME IN THEIR TENNIS SHOES AND BRING THEIR SKATES.
- **DO NOT WEAR BOBBY PINS IN THE HAIR.** THEY ARE A HAZARD FOR SKATERS, ESPECIALLY IF THEY FALL OUT OR A SKATER FALLS WITH THEM IN.
- GET PLENTY OF REST AND DRINK PLENTY OF FLUIDS – IT'S A BUSY 4 DAYS. IF YOUR SKATER IS NOT FEELING WELL, PLEASE DON'T COME.
- PLEASE REMIND SKATERS TO BE GOOD LISTENERS TO THEIR CHAIRMOMS AND OTHER SKATERS. BE RESPECTFUL OF EACH OTHER.
- **REMINDER THAT YOU MUST BRING A CHANGE OF CLOTHES ON SUNDAY. ALL COSTUMES MUST BE RETURNED TO THE CHAIRMOM FOR YOUR GROUP ON SUNDAY BY 4:30 P.M. OR YOU WILL BE CHARGED \$50 FROM THE CLUB AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SKATE NEXT SEASON IF THEY ARE NOT RETURNED OR DUES PAID.**
