Individual Lettering Criteria

2023-2024 Skating Season

- Skaters must follow the CFSC Handbook, Crookston School District Handbooks, Crookston Park & Recreation's City Policies, and conform to MN State High School League. (Academic Ineligibility, Drugs & Alcohol Policy, etc.)
- Be a positive role model by displaying a good attitude, work ethic and behavior.
- Be a current member in good standing with USFSA and Crookston Figure Skating Club.
- Lettering deadline is February 28. Skaters are required to mail their signed lettering requirements summary sheets and additional required materials to the CFSC PO Box 145 by February 28. It is the responsibility of your private coach to verify that you have completed the necessary requirements. Upon receiving the lettering committee will verify your application and keep a journal of all yearly letter winners.
- The lettering criteria will be responsibility of skater and coach to ensure that she/he has obtained enough points during the lettering year (March 1 – Feb 28) in order to be eligible.
- It is the responsibility of the skater to get copies of the results sheets from competitions they have competed in, print out of the USFSA Tests you have passed for the lettering year. To obtain copies of you USFSA Test results go to www.usfa.org – click on Members only on the right side, type in your USFSA# and your password. (If you do not have a password you can register when you are on the website.) Next, on the left side click on Test History.
- Make copies of your competition results sheets and your USFSA Tests Passed and attach them to your summary sheet.

Requirements to Letter:

1. Lettering year is March 1 – February 28
2. The first year you will be able to letter is 7th grade
3. You MUST pass 2 out of the 3
 - Juvenile MIF (required)
 - And/or All PreE Silver Dances
 - And/or Juvenile Free Skate Test
4. Skaters MUST compete in 2 Individual USFSA sanctioned Figure Skating Competitions during the lettering year.
5. You MUST earn 13 points in the lettering year in order to letter. You may pick from the following list for your points. POINTS:
 - Moves in the Field USFSA Test passed2 per test
 - Individual Dance USFSA Test passed2 per test
 - Free Skate USFSA Test Passed2 per test
 - USFSA Sanctioned Competition4 per competition
 - Skating Performance in front of an audience...1 per performance (ex. Exhibition, hockey games, ice show)

Requirements to Re-Letter in succeeding years

1. You MUST earn 10 points (see point system above)
2. You MUST test and pass a USFSA Test Session
3. You MUST compete in a USFSA, ISI or Skate Canada Sanctioned Competition.
